Volunteers must complete a CORI check (cost covered by FamilyAid). There is also an opportunity to assemble 60 goody bags filled with sensory toys & art supplies (\sim \$3,000-4,000 cost).

YES Track and Field volunteer coaches join an energetic, collaborative, and inclusive group of adults who are excited to coach Boston youth and help develop their running, jumping, and throwing skills. Volunteers do not need to have previous track experience.

Great for individuals or groups of up to 12 volunteers. Minimum donation of \$500 recommended for corporate groups. Ages 12 & up.

Feast or Flounder with New England Culinary Arts Training (NECAT)

During this fun, "Chopped-style" event, two teams of five will be assigned a NECAT Chef Instructor to prepare dishes using a mystery basket of ingredients. Great for individuals and groups of up to 7 volunteers. Ages 15 & up. Minimum donation of \$750 for corporate groups.

FamilyAid needs up to 25 birthday party kits. Recommended budget is \$1,500-2,000 for the cost of supplies.
