Healthy Waltham's Food Pantry IN PERSON GROUPS INDIVIDUALS

During two hour long volunteer sessions, volunteers sort and quality check baby and toddler items in Hyde Park. The exact project that volunteers work on is dependent on what recent donations they have received, but examples include sorting toys by age and sorting clothing by size and season. Great for groups of up to 10 volunteers per shift.

Julie's Family Learning Center needs volunteers to sort clothing, toys and food, ensuring old and damaged items are removed & unneeded clothing is brought to Goodwill.

Great for individuals or groups of up to 3 volunteers. Volunteers must be 16+ and able to bend down to pick up storage bins and lift up heavy items.



Set up a safe place for homeless youth to sleep at night

Volunteers will set up the Welcome Center for Bridge Over Troubled Water by wiping down all surfaces and desk stations, moving furniture, sweeping floors, setting up cots, taking trash bags to lobby, and helping with meal preparation, if needed. A gift card will be left on each cot. Up to 5 volunteers per night. Volunteers must be 21+. \$180 per shift.
